

Residential Toilet Rebate

Program Overview

Single-family, residential customers of the any PUD-owned water systems can significantly reduce water use by replacing toilets and to receive a rebate of \$50.00 per toilet for doing so.

Any toilet which meets the program criteria, purchased between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022, is eligible for the rebate. Rebates will be applied as a credit to customer account, are limited to two rebates per customer and are offered on a first-come, first-served basis, for up to a total of 50 rebates during 2022.

Program Criteria

Toilets eligible for rebate must be high-efficiency toilets on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) WaterSense list. Toilets may be purchased at a retailer of the customer's choosing.

Participants in the program must be residential customers of any PUD-owned water system and the address at which the toilet is installed must be within the PUD's water system service area. Rebates are for replacement of existing less efficient toilets and are not for new construction. Homeowners may install the toilets themselves, or they may hire a plumber or contractor to do the job. Installation may be subject to verification by PUD personnel.

Application Process

In order to be eligible to receive a rebate, a completed application must be submitted to:

A purchase receipt or invoice (a copy is acceptable) with the manufacturer's model name and number must accompany the completed and signed application. All applications must be received by January 15, 2023, and the toilet must have been purchased in 2022 to be eligible for the \$50.00 rebate.



Toilets are the main source of water use in the house, accounting for nearly 30 percent of residential indoor water use.

Toilets installed prior to 1994 use 3.5 gallons of water per flush, or even more depending upon age.

Today's standard toilets use 1.6 gallons of water per flush.

WaterSense labeled toilets are independently certified to meet rigorous criteria for both performance and efficiency and use 1.28 gallons of water per flush, 20 percent less than today's standard toilets.

By replacing old, inefficient toilets with WaterSense labeled models, the average family can reduce water used for toilets by 20 to 60 percent.

Remember, only WaterSense labeled toilets are eligible for the \$50.00 rebate. WaterSense-labeled toilets are 20 percent more efficient than today's standard toilets. For more information, including the list of WaterSense labeled toilets, visit the EPA's website at www.epa.gov/watersense/products.

Please note that many toilets are sold in two parts, with the tank and bowl sold separately. When components combine to make a WaterSense labeled product, tanks should include the words "when used in combination with [bowl model number/name]" near the label and similarly with bowl labeling. Only the combinations provided on the WaterSense website listed above have been certified to bear the WaterSense label and are, therefore, eligible for the \$50.00 rebate.

Prior to purchasing and installing your new toilet, feel free to contact the PUD to verify your choice is eligible for the \$50.00 rebate.

When shopping for your new toilet, look for the WaterSense logo!

TOILET REBATE ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

The property must be located within a TPUD owned water system and have an active account.

The applicant must purchase and install a WaterSense labeled toilet.

The applicant must agree to dispose of the old toilet as required by law and once completed to allow PUD personnel to verify toilet installation.

An applicant is limited to two toilet rebates per account, with each rebate worth \$50.00.

Toilets purchased between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022 are eligible for a rebate.

The applicant must submit a completed application, including a purchase receipt.



Residential Toilet Rebate Application

If you are a single-family, residential customer of any PUD-owned water system and purchased and replaced a WaterSense-labeled toilet at your home in 2022, you may be eligible to receive a \$50.00 rebate, credited to your water account.
