MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COMMISSION MEETING OF NOVEMBER 14, 2023

The first regular Commission meeting for November 2023 of the Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 1 of Thurston County was called to order on November 14, 2023. The meeting commenced at 5:00 p.m. Commissioners Chris Stearns, Linda Oosterman, and Russell E. Call to Order:

Commissioner Stearns called the regular meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of Agenda:

Commissioner Oosterman made a motion to amend the agenda to include Resolution 23-54, Censure of a Public Official, as the last item addressed under Action Items; Commissioner Olsen seconded the motion. The motion passed with two votes in favor; Commissioner Stearns abstained from the vote. Commissioner Olsen made a motion to approve the agenda as amended: Commissioner Oosterman seconded the motion; the motion passed with all in favor.

Discussion - Meeting with WPUDA President and Executive Director

GM Weidenfeller relayed a request to the Commissioners to meet with the WPUDA President and Executive Director at the regular Commission meeting on December 12, 2023. The Board discussed this topic, and Commissioner Olsen requested an agenda for the meeting with WPUDA. Commissioner Oosterman requested a later meeting date.

Discussion – Hazard Mitigation Plans

DPC Gubbe presented an update on her work on the Hazard Mitigation Plans for Thurston and Lewis counties. Commissioner Stearns commented on the water resources program through the state.

1st Reading – Resolution 23-47, 1st Amended 2023 Operating Budget

FCSM Tartt presented Resolution 23-47 which would adopt the first amendment to the 2023 Operating Budget.

1st Reading – Resolution 23-48, 3rd Amended 2023 Capital Budget

FCSM Tartt presented Resolution 23-48 which would adopt the third amendment to the 2023 Capital Budget.

1st Reading – Resolution 23-49, DWSRF Construction Contract, Pattison 500 Tri-Lake Booster Station Replacement

DPC Gubbe presented Resolution 23-49 which would grant authorization to GM Weidenfeller to sign the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) construction contract for the Tri-Lake booster station at the Pattison 500 water system.

1st Reading – Resolution 23-51, 2024 Employee Job Classifications and Salary Ranges (Updated) AGM Parker introduced Resolution 23-51 which would update the job classifications and salary ranges for employees in 2024.

1st Reading – Resolution 23-52, Thurston PUD 2024 Vaccination Incentive

GM Weidenfeller introduced Resolution 23-52 which would adopt a vaccination incentive for Commissioners and District employees in 2024.

Action/Approval Items:

Resolution 23-43, Construction Contract for Kiwa Drive Mainline Replacement (Pattison 500)

DPC Gubbe briefly presented Resolution 23-43. Commissioner Olsen made a motion to adopt

Resolution 23-43 as presented: Commissioner Stearns seconded the motion; the motion passed with all in favor.

Resolution 23-46, Refund Tax Levy

GM Weidenfeller briefly presented Resolution 23-46. **Commissioner Olsen made a motion to adopt** Resolution 23-46 as presented: Commissioner Oosterman seconded the motion; the motion passed with all in favor.

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Resolution 23-54, Censure of a Public Official

Commissioner Stearns stated that he concurred with the action by the two other Commissioners, as it was not his intention to cause harm. Commissioner Oosterman made a motion to adopt Resolution 23-54 as presented; Commissioner Olsen seconded the motion. The motion passed with two votes in favor; Commissioner Stearns abstained from the vote.

Commissioner Olsen asked about the review process for the General Manager, and GM Weidenfeller addressed this question.

Commissioner Topics, Discussions, and Reports:

Commissioners Olsen and Oosterman did not have reports. Commissioner Oosterman thanked staff for their written reports.

Commissioner Stearns reported on his attendance at the most recent Thurston Regional Planning Council (TRPC) and Water Resources Advisory Committee (WRAC) meetings. The District was mentioned at the latter meeting. Commissioner Stearns also gave an update on Washington State Department of Ecology proposed Policy 2030 and housing trends.
